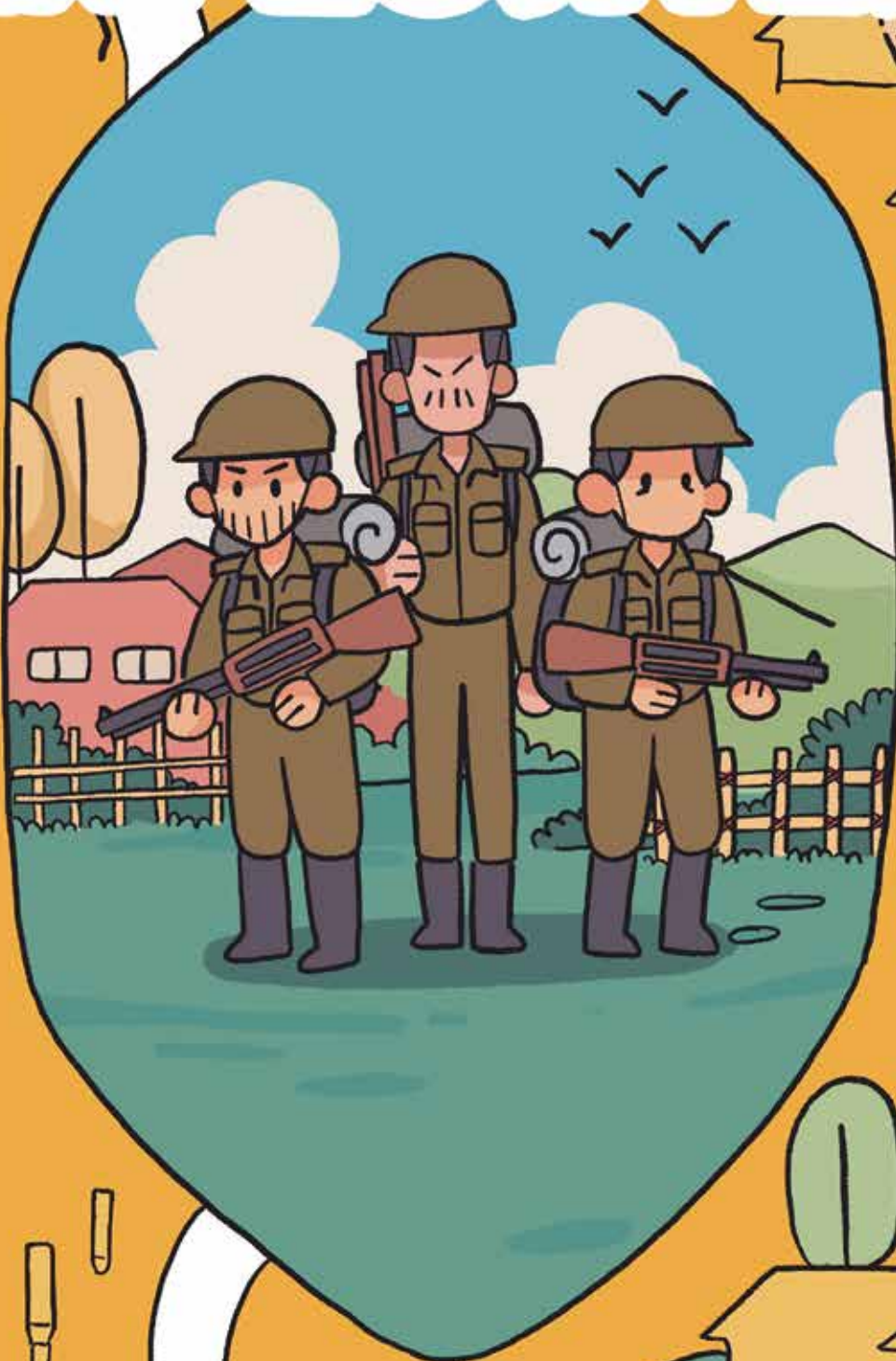
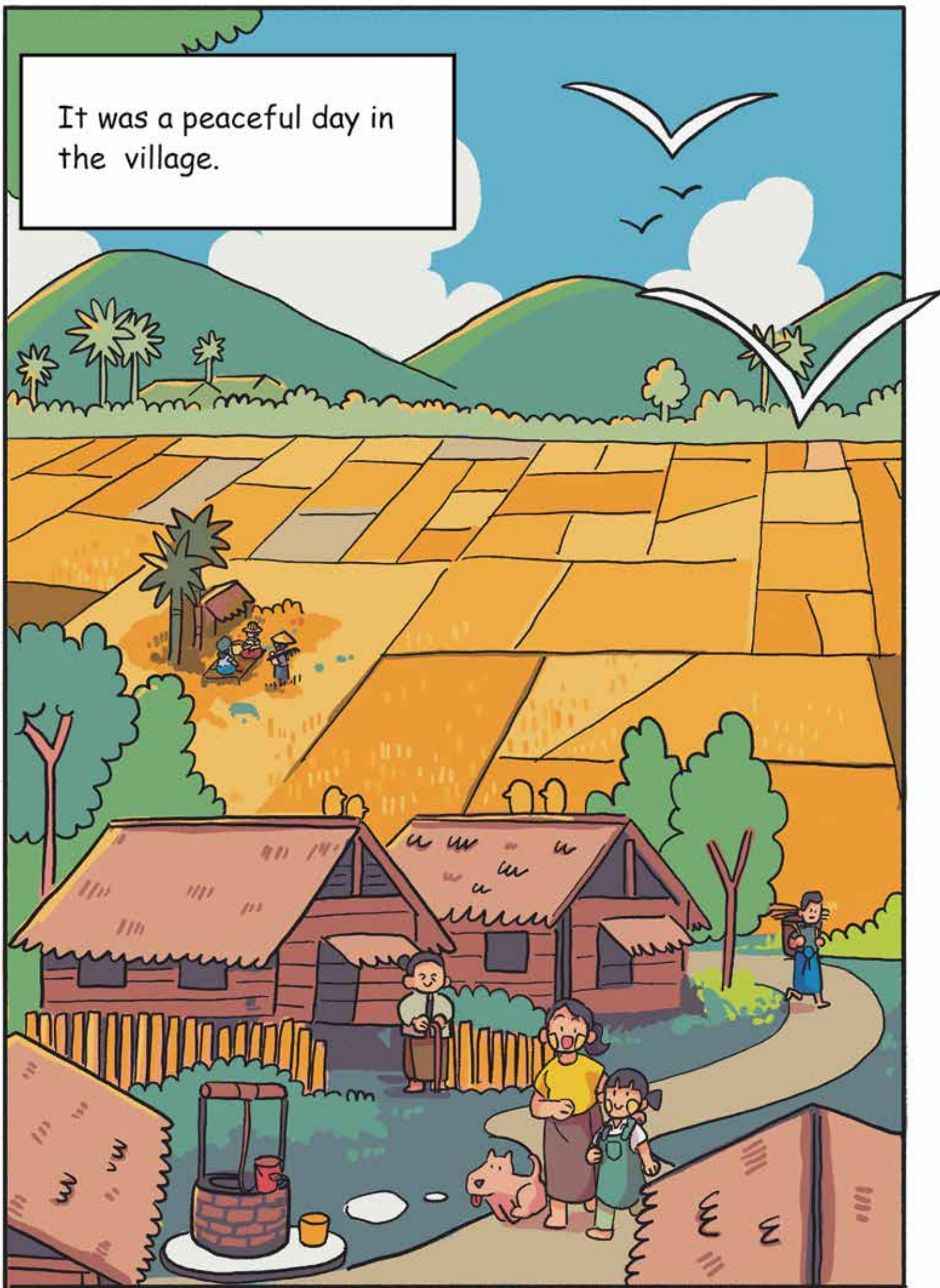


WARNINGS ON THE USE OF EXPLOSIVES

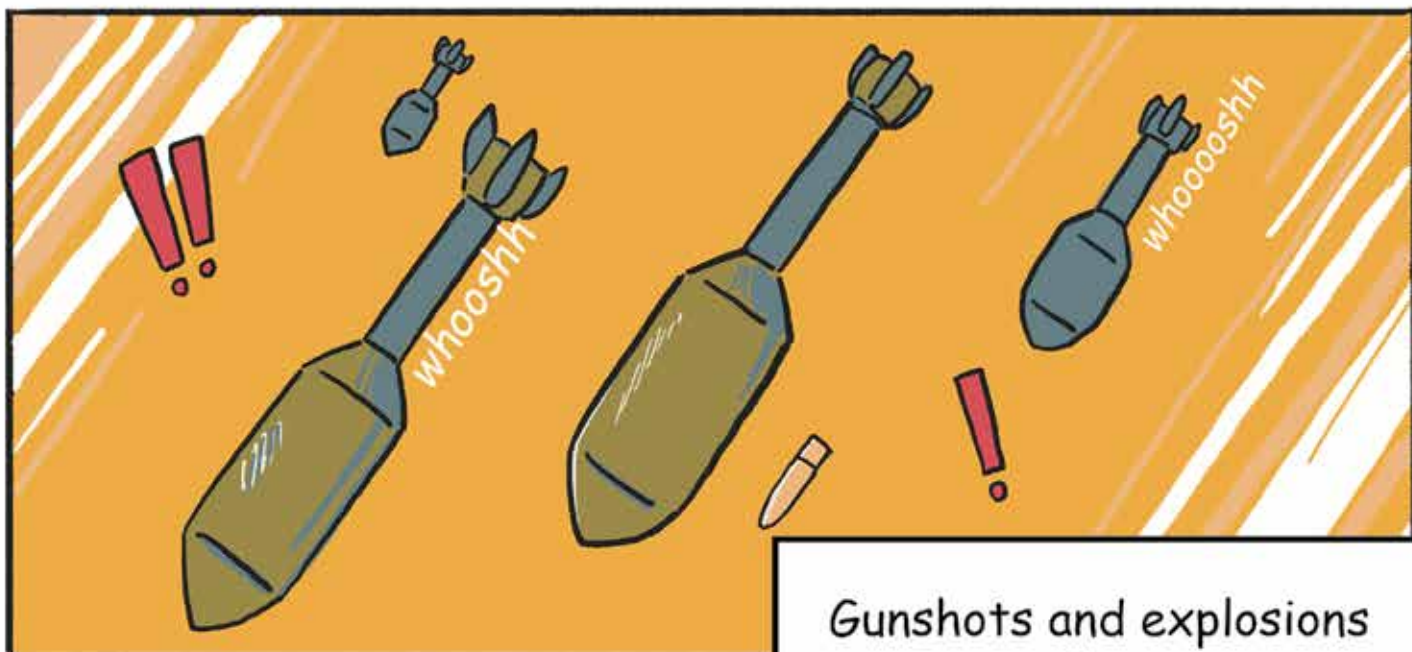




It was a peaceful day in the village.



Suddenly, the conflict erupts inside the village.



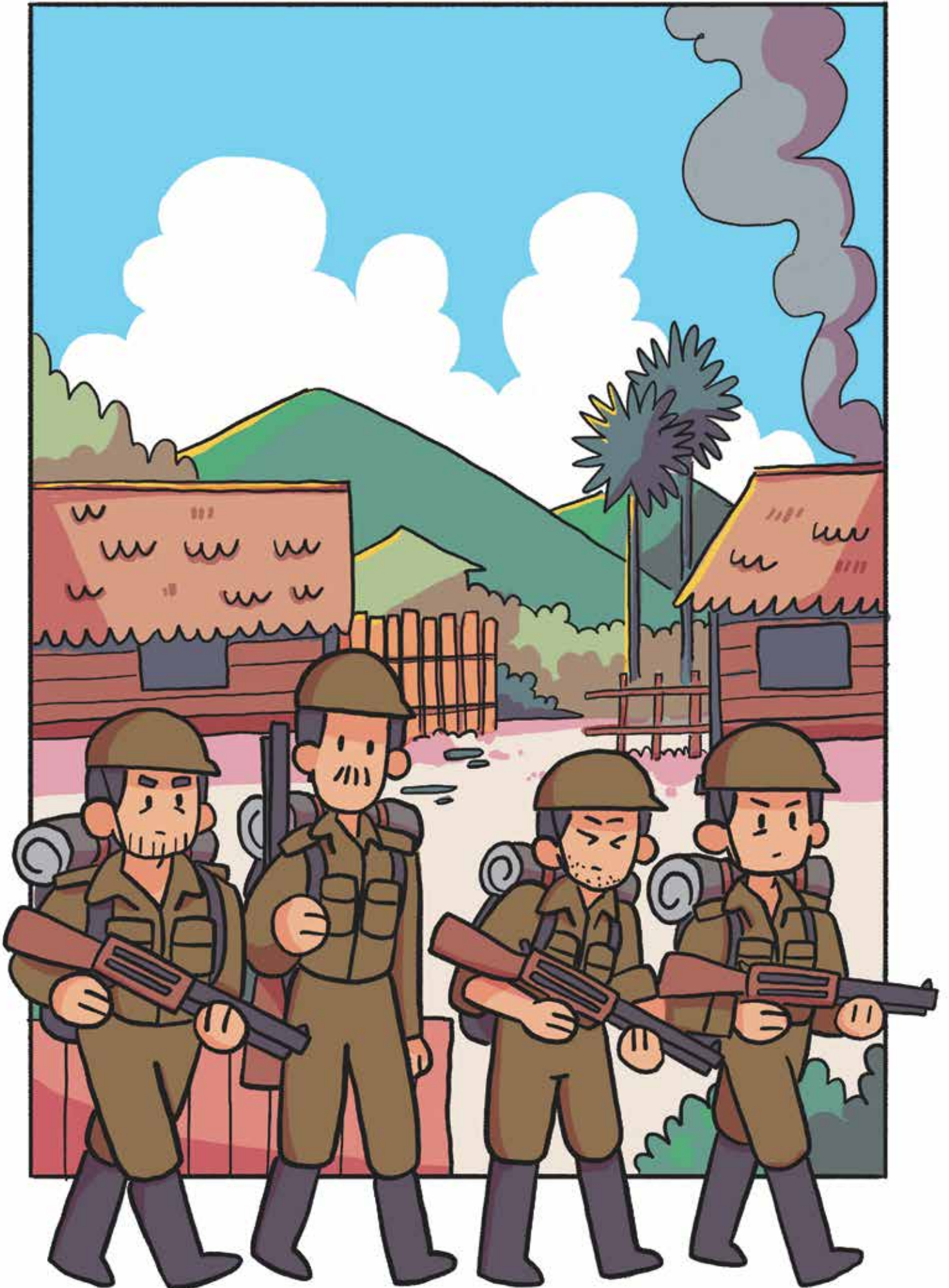
Gunshots and explosions are everywhere.

Don't use heavy weapons in public areas!



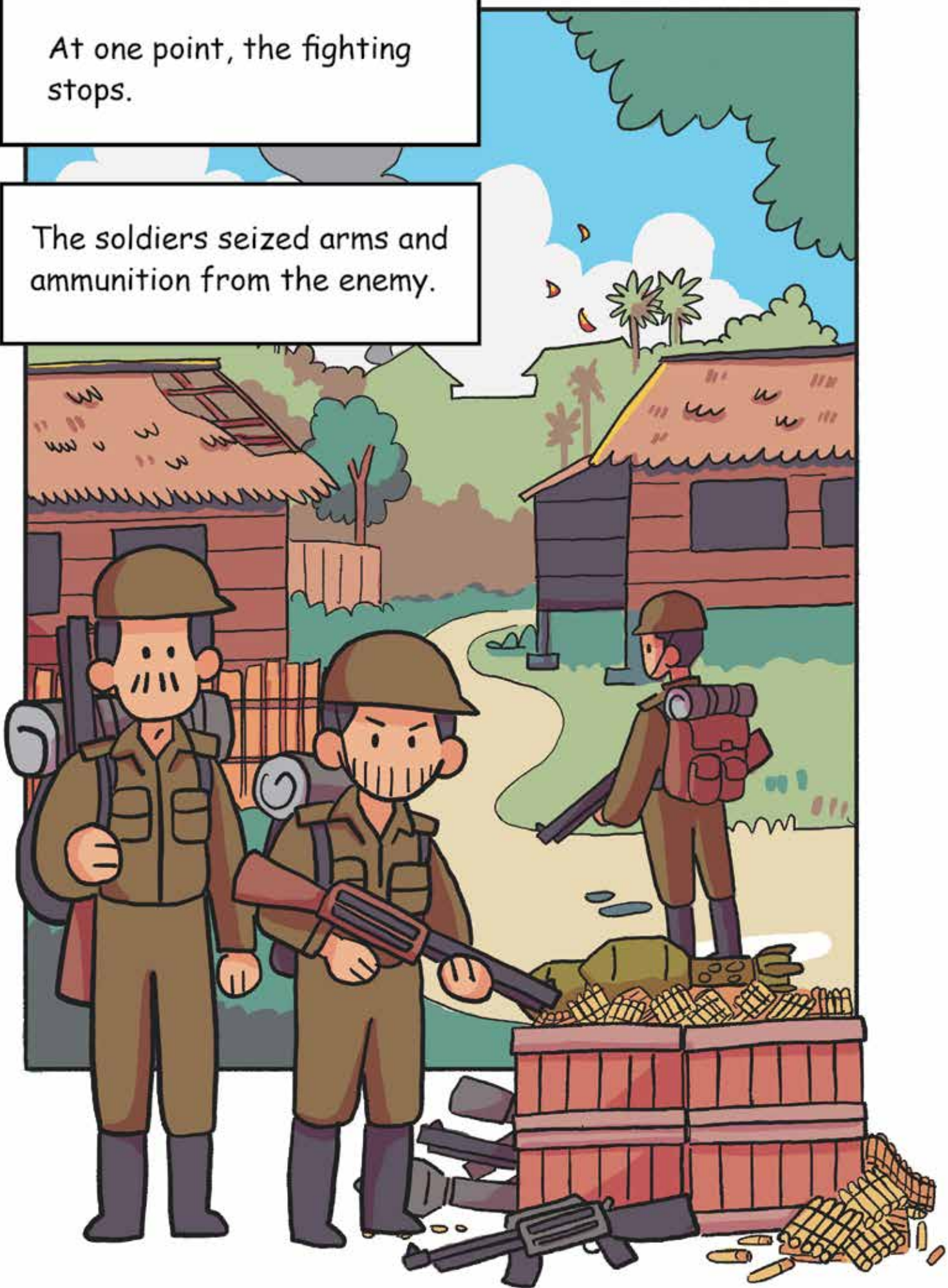
Do not use explosive devices in populated areas.

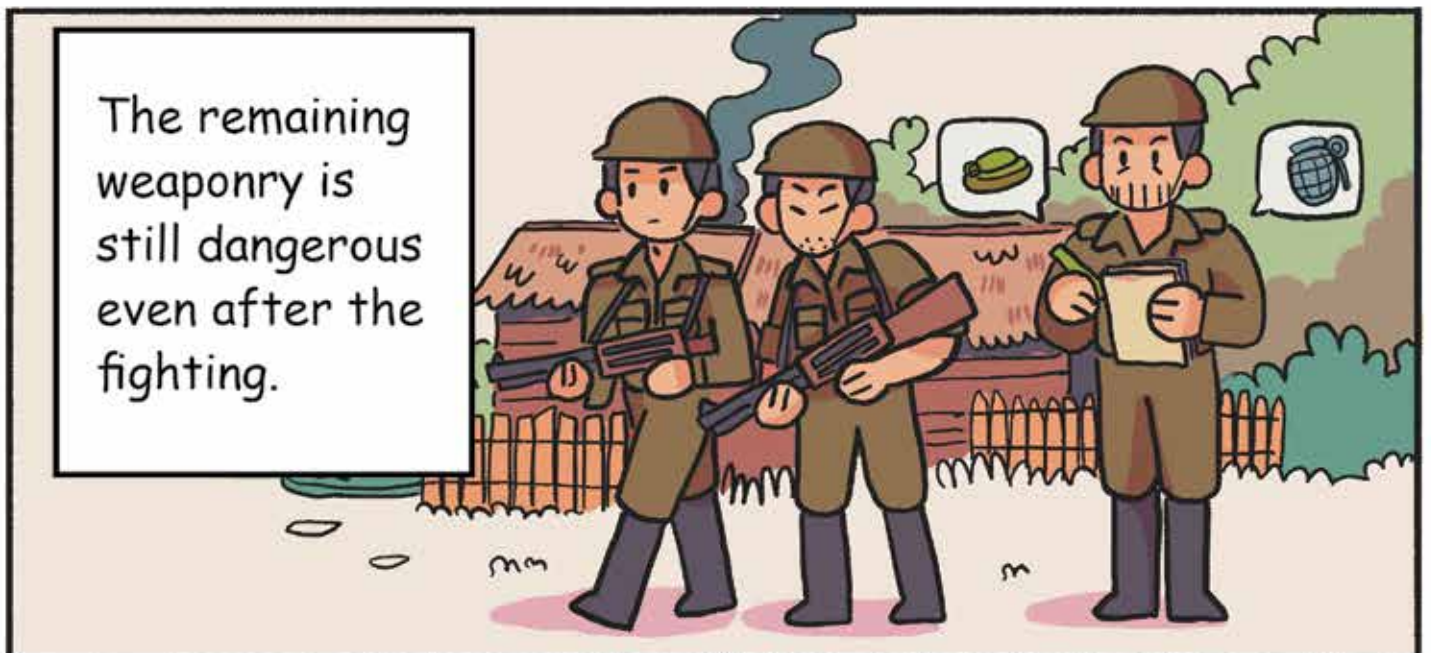


Do not make, use, stockpile, or sell victim-activated explosive devices.

Report it to the authorities.



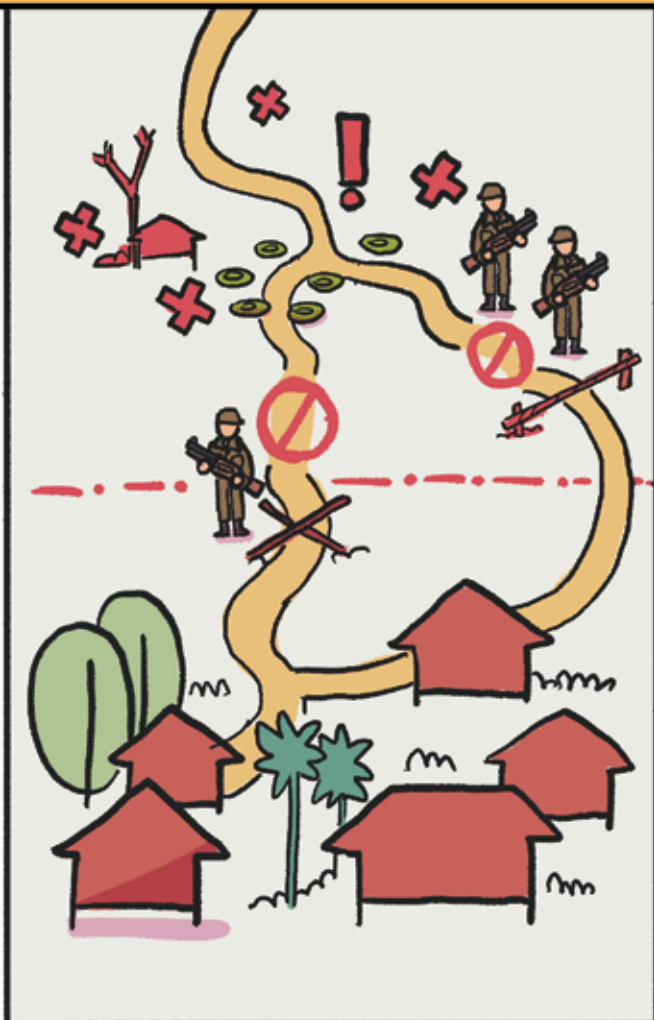
Warn civilians and communities of the dangers of explosive devices.
